TRACY ARM FJORD GLACIER CRUISE Full Day, Roundtrip Cruise - Adult \$120/pp, Child (age 12yrs & under) \$80/pp

Throughout your cruise you will have the opportunity to cruise the best of Alaska. Snow-capped peaks, sheer palisades of glacier carved granite, icebergs, view Bald Eagles, watch for whales, porpoises, and sea lions. Near the glaciers, hundreds of seals rest on the floating icebergs. Bears wander the steep shorelines looking for food, while goats and eagles watch from the cliffs above. Watch and listen for the thunder of a calving glacier. If you don't have time for Glacier Bay then this is the tour for you and just half the cost of Glacier Bay.

JUNEAU HELICOPTER TOUR

Icefield Excursion: Starting at \$192/pp

This tour is approximately 1 hour in length including 25-30 minutes flight time and 15-20 minutes on the glacier with the pilot as the glacier guide. This tour is a pilot's choice in the sense that your pilot has autonomy as to the landing area and flight routes used as a single helicopter for a more remote peaceful Alaskan experience. An additional 45 minutes each direction for transportation and outfitting is required.

Adventure Tour: Starting at \$315/pp (minimum 3-persons)

This tour is approximately 90 minutes in length, this includes 50-60 minutes flight time that enables passengers to view more of the immense Juneau Icefield when weather permits. This 1 1/2 hour total tour takes you deep into the Juneau Icefield and lands in one of our permitted areas. A large portion of the 1500 square mile Juneau Icefield may be observed enroute. Weather permitting an alternate route returning to the airport provides additional scenic possibilities. Pilots provide custom flights. A 15 minute walk supplements the narrated flight over the glacier with your pilot/guide answering additional questions or will use your camera to take photos of you and your friends. Transportation to and from the ship docks or selected downtown locations provided as needed. An additional 45 minutes each direction for transportation and outfitting is required Minimum 3 people for this exciting tour.

Dog Sled Tour: Starting at \$395/pp

"Once in a lifetime" experience. You will be transported to the heliport where you will start this very special adventure. The helicopter flight is only one part of this legendary experience that includes flying over the Juneau Ice Field to the dog camp, a kennel tour and the dogsled ride. When you take off, glaciers are seemingly within arm's reach. Glacier-carved mountains will unfold in front of your eyes as you embark on your flight to the camp. When you arrive at your destination, you will share this adventure with 80 Alaskan huskies and hear unique personal accounts of the Iditarod, back country experiences and have an opportunity to ask questions.

TAKU LODGE FLIGHT & FEAST Adult \$225/pp, Child (11yrs and under) \$185/pp

For the ultimate Alaskan experience, fly past five glaciers before landing at the Taku Glacier Lodge. You will experience the best of Alaska, a place where bear, moose, wolves and other northern creatures are free to roam. At this historic lodge with view of Hole-In-The-Wall Glacier you will feast on Alaska King Salmon, cooked over an alderwood fire. Before the flight back to Juneau, you'll have time to stroll along the rainforest trails, take an interpretive nature walk or just sit and enjoy the glacier view. Tour takes approximately 3 hours.

JUNEAU CITY & MENDENHALL GLACIER TOUR Starting from \$30/pp

Includes a historical downtown Juneau tour plus traveling past our Governor's Mansion, 40-45 minutes at Mendenhall Glacier, and a tour of Macaulay Salmon Hatchery taking about 40 minutes. Fully narrated, includes hatchery admission fee. (Does not include admission to Mendenhall Glacier Visitor Center.) Duration: 2 1/2 hours.

ZIPLINE ADVENTURES Adult (10yrs & above) \$115/pp (weight recommendations 80-250lbs)

MENDENHALL GLACIER FLOAT TRIP Adult \$99/pp, Child (12 & under) \$66/pp (children must weight at least 50lbs to fit into life jackets)

An adventure awaits you as you paddle out onto Mendenhall Lake near the face of the majestic Mendenhall Glacier in the Tongass National Forest. Your journey takes you on an exciting ride down the Mendenhall River, which flows from the glacier. A sense of adventure, film for your camera and an appreciation of natural beauty and cultural history are all that you'll need. Join the adventure and paddle along with your guide, or sit back and let us do the work as you take in the spectacular scenery. Knowledgeable guides provide narration on the legends and landscapes of the area. We provide rain gear, boots, and life jackets provided. Duration: 4 hours

MENDENHALL GLACIER \$3 entrance fee for 16 & over at the visitor center. Open May – Sept 8am-730pm

The US Forest Service Mendenhall Glacier Visitor Center is located in the Mendenhall Valley, 12 miles from downtown Juneau. Visitors may reach the visitor center by city bus, taxi, tour bus or rental car. The city bus drops visitors a mile and a half from the visitor center. The Mendenhall Glacier Visitor Center provides a high-quality recreation experience with emphasis on glacial phenomena, ecosystems and protection of fish and wildlife. Staff at the visitor center are available to answer questions about the area.

GLACIER GARDENS RAINFOREST ADVENTURE Adult \$19.95/pp, Child (12yrs & under) \$15.95/pp

Glacier Gardens Rainforest Adventure is a botanical garden located in Juneau, Alaska. Tour the gardens to view the trademark upside down trees! Tour 50 acres of Southeast Alaska's lush rainforest, offering landscaping, floral design and scenic vistas, with guide providing narrative along the way. Covered shuttles take you to breathtaking scenic vistas on top of Thunder Mountain. Enjoy our Atrium with exclusive floral design. Also has a landscape nursery that offers landscaping and overwintering services, flowers, hanging baskets, fuschias, and seasonal offerings such as bulbs and Holiday greens and trees.

ALASKA STATE MUSEUM Adult \$5/pp, Child under 18 years – Free

The Alaska State Museum has been the official repository of Alaska's history since 1900. It is home to more than 23,000 artifacts, works of fine art and natural history and features both permanent and temporary exhibitions. The Museum dedicates more than half of its exhibition space to permanent displays ranging from a life-sized eagle nesting tree located in a Southeast Alaska rainforest setting to a scaled-down replica of the stern of Capt. George Vancouver's ship, "Discovery," dry-docked in the Museum's children's room. Among its most popular exhibits are clothing, weapons, tools and ceremonial objects from the distinct Alaska Native populations as well as icons and other memorabilia from Russian American days. Volunteers offer tours of the Museum during the summer and by special arrangement during the rest of the year. A Museum Store, operated by the Friends of the Alaska State Museum, offers a variety of Alaska Native handcrafted items, art and jewelry, as well as Alaska books, post cards and gifts for children. The Museum is located downtown Juneau within walking distance of the cruise ship terminal at 395 Whittier St. Summer hours are 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. seven days a week.

MOUNT ROBERTS TRAMWAY Adult \$23.95/pp, Child \$12.50/pp, Child 5 & under: Free

Tickets allow all day unlimited rides and include viewing of Seeing Daylight and the Juneau Raptor Center's live Bald Eagle exhibit. Allow a minimum of one hour for a complete tramway experience.

Soar to new heights in scenic adventure aboard the Mount Roberts Tramway, Juneau's top Attraction, and experience the best of Southeast Alaska. Located downtown Juneau where you board a tramcar that provides an exhilarating ride through the Southeast Alaska rainforest to the 1800 foot level of Mount Roberts. Experience one of the most expansive and beautiful views offered in all Alaska, from the Chilkat Mountains to the north, down the Gastineau Channel to the lands and waterways of the south, west to Douglas Island, and east into Silver Bow Basin where gold was discovered near the head of Gold Creek in 1880.

Once at the top, enjoy the amenities of our multi-million dollar mountain complex that houses the Chilkat Theater, Raven Eagle Gifts, the Timberline Bar & Grill and offers access to The Nature Center, an eagle exhibit and the extensive Mount Roberts improved trail system. Visitors are introduced to the Tlingit culture through the award winning film Seeing Daylight, shown every half hour in the Chilkat Theater. There are also frequent theater performances by a local Tlingit actor sharing the story of his clan's origin. Native artists are often featured in the complex working on wood, fossilized ivory or silver carvings, making dolls, sewing garments, beading or creating large totem poles out of cedar logs.

MACAULAY SALMON HATCHERY Adult \$3.25/pp, Child \$1.75/pp

Located just 2.5 miles from downtown, the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery is truly a sight to be seen by all Juneau's visitors and locals alike. Designed with the visitor in mind, the Macaulay Salmon Hatchery provides amazing views of spectacular salmon sights and allows visitors to our facility to learn first-hand about Alaska's salmon. From the elevated entrance, visitors get a birds-eye view of outside operations as they listen to a 5 to 10 minute informative commentary. A knowledgeable tour guide explains the fascinating life of the Pacific salmon and the workings of our hatchery. Inside the facility visitors will find museum-like interpretive displays, beautiful saltwater aquariums, and a souvenir shop featuring local salmon products and novelties.

ADVENTURE HIKE Adult \$79/pp, Child \$49/pp (4½ hour tour – 3½ hour hiking)

Experience a day of world-class hiking. The pace will be brisk, the day unforgettable. Cascading waterfalls, serene alpine meadows, and quiet forest glens are just a few of the treasured places reached only on foot. Along the way your naturalist/guide will provide knowledge and perspective on the region's natural and cultural history, and will share his or her favorite local stories. Your guide will select the trail best suited for the day's hiking conditions. Weather will be of particular consideration; in this region of mountains and fiords, conditions can vary quickly and dramatically. You may find yourself hiking high above a shimmering glacier lake, or along a rushing mountain stream. The forest is thick at times, nearly impenetrable except for the pathway. During much of the hike the views are panoramic, encompassing expanses of glacier-carved wilderness. There are many opportunities for photography along the trail, and frequent interpretive stops. Whether you are interested in violets or eagles, geology or the rainforest, this adventurous hike will provide you with great exercise and lasting memories of Alaska.
